Registration/Tuition Information

In order for pre-registration materials to be sent to students in a timely manner, applications and tuition payments should be received by June 15. No applications or checks should be sent to Pomona College. All correspondence should be sent directly to the school address.

Registration will be on Sunday, July 11, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. Students are expected to attend an Orientation Meeting for their class that afternoon. You should check in at Frank Dining Hall before your Orientation Meeting begins.

You will receive acknowledgment of your application by mail. Further details will follow in the Arrival Packet.

Tuition

There are two tuition/lodging options available to students of Western CUNA Management School. While it is highly recommended that students choose on-campus status so that they may participate fully in school activities, some may find it more convenient to be off-campus.

Option A—On-Campus, \$2,785

Option B—Off-Campus, \$2,660

Option A fees cover tuition, room, all meals, refreshment breaks, texts, and materials.

NOTE: Fees for applications postmarked after May 15, 2010 increase by \$200 for each option.

Scholarships

Scholarships are offered by WCMS, State Leagues and Chapters, and the Richard Myles Johnson Foundation.

Scholarships offered by Leagues and Chapters are applied for through the individual bodies. Deadlines may vary, check with your League or Chapter.

A scholarship application is included with this booklet. Applications must be received by the League of the scholarship applicant in time to be forwarded to the school by April 28, 2010. The Scholarship Committee will meet after that date to award scholarships. Applicants will be notified by approximately May 31.

Students who are awarded scholarships after tuition has been paid will receive a refund, sent to the person or credit union who issued the tuition check, after the school session.

Airport Transportation

Ground transportation to and from the Ontario, California airport is available by pre-arrangement.

Early Arrival

Students who wish to arrive on Saturday, July 10, should inform the school in writing and include an additional \$75 with their tuition.

Arrival Packet

Updated arrival instructions, maps, etc., will be mailed to all registering students.

Graduation Ceremonies

A banquet honoring the third year graduating class will be held Thursday evening, July 22. Graduation ceremonies will follow the banquet. All students attend. Other guests and alumni are invited to attend the graduation ceremonies.

Departure

The school session will conclude on Friday, July 23 following lunch.

First and second year students should make travel arrangements to leave campus no earlier than 1 p.m. Shuttles from the school campus to Ontario Airport will be provided.
